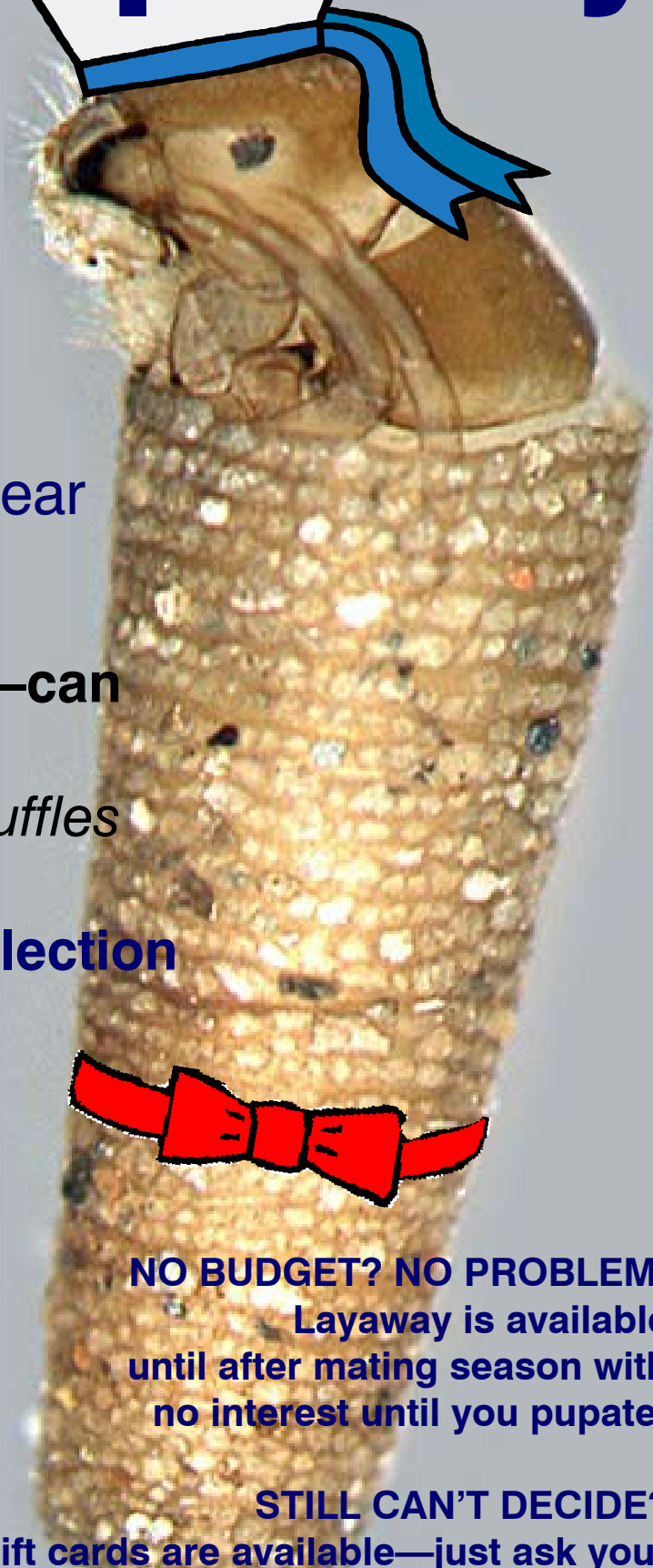

**All equipment and alcohol (denatured preserving) are provided—just bring yourself and a friend.**

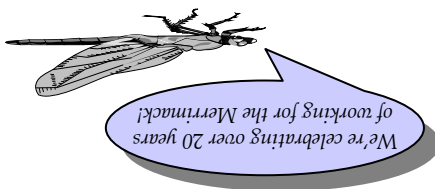

**Directions to St. Paul's School from Interstate 93 North:** Take I-89 north from Concord to exit 2 to Clinton Street. At the end of the ramp turn right onto Clinton Street. Follow signs and take left onto Langley Parkway. Continue to end to intersection of Pleasant Street (across from Concord Hospital). Turn left onto Pleasant Street. Go about a half mile and turn left at the St. Paul's School sign onto Dunbarton Road. Payson Hall will be on your right (same parking lot as Memorial Hall) across from athletic fields. Enter building from rear parking lot (due to construction at front of building).
