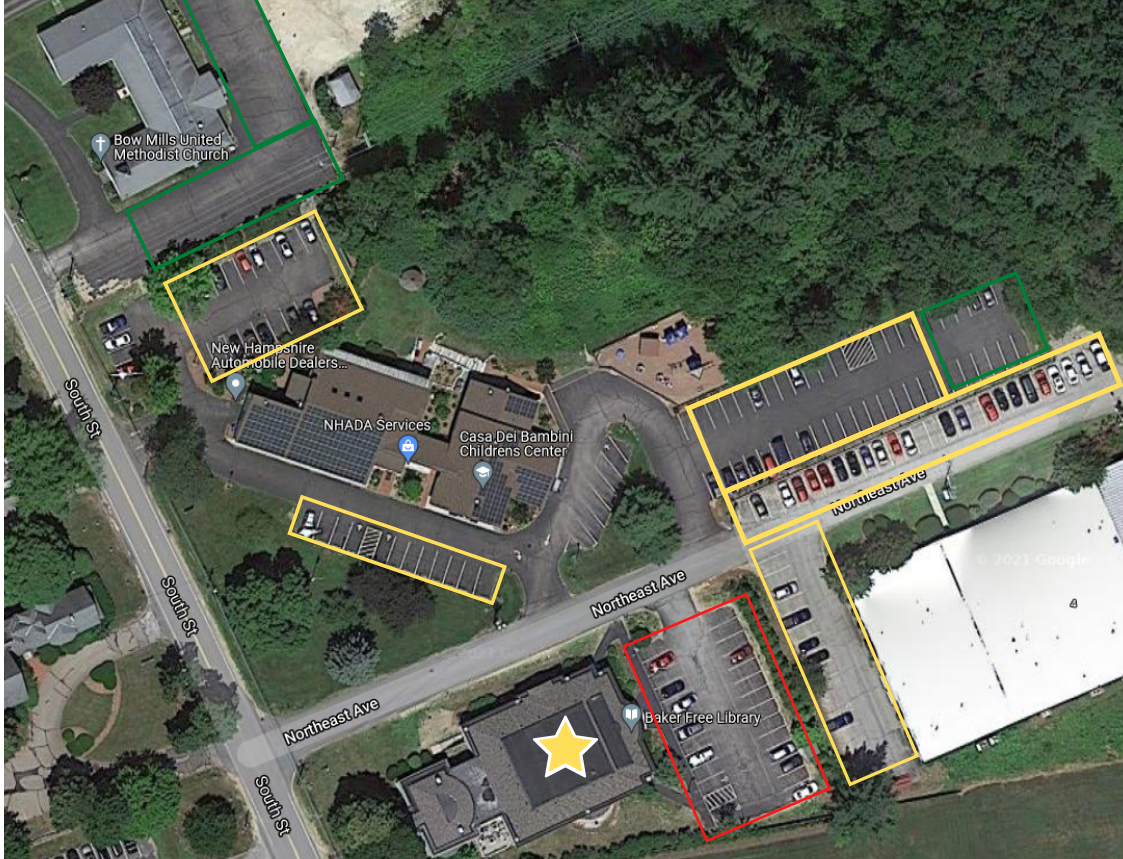

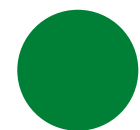
You are here. *Baker Free Library.*
